PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Jack Nadel International (JNI) has established the Marty Nadel Scholarship Fund. The scholarship is named in the memory of Marty Nadel, President of JNI, long-standing supporter of D.A.R.E. and recipient of the D.A.R.E. America Lifetime Achievement Award. The scholarship was created to recognize and acknowledge the tremendous contribution made to the youth of our nation by D.A.R.E. Instructors. The objective of the scholarship is to encourage the personal growth, community involvement and academic achievement of children of D.A.R.E. Instructors and to provide financial assistance to students pursuing a college degree. The scholarship is awarded for the period of one year. Applicants and scholarship recipient(s) may reapply during subsequent funding cycles.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for a Marty Nadel Scholarship, you must be:

- The dependent of a current D.A.R.E. Instructor who has delivered the D.A.R.E. program for at least one year,
- A current high school or home-schooled senior anticipating graduation during this academic semester,
- Planning to pursue a degree at an accredited post-secondary institution, or
- Presently enrolled and a student in good standing at an accredited post-secondary institution, and
- Upon award of scholarship be enrolled **full-time** in a degree-seeking program at an accredited college or university (enrollment verified for the Fall semester).

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants **must** submit:

- Scholarship Application Form (available on dare.com)
- An essay (see Essay Format and Rules)
- Most recent grade transcripts
- Proof of official request for transfer of SAT/ACT and grade transcript
- Copy of diploma/certificate of graduation (graduating high school seniors)

All application materials must be submitted as a complete package and must be received no later than 5:00pm PDST, June 15, 2007. ESSAY FORMAT AND RULES:

The essay is to address why the applicant believes they should be selected for award of the Marty Nadel Scholarship. The essay must be a minimum of 250 words, not to exceed 500 words, written in English, double spaced, 12 pt. font, and have one-inch margins. The essay must be the original work of the applicant and not violate any copyright.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS

Scholarship application submissions will be judged equally on the following criteria.

- student's academic achievement,
- results of ACT or SAT tests,
- involvement in civic and community leadership and
- quality and content of the essay.

The Marty Nadel Scholarship Fund selection committee will review the scholarship application packages. The selection committee will select scholarship recipient(s), the decision of the committee will be final.

Award of the scholarship is based upon merit. The Scholarship Fund does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, or disability.

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION

Only students chosen to receive a scholarship will be notified of their selection. Selection notification will be accomplished July 2, 2007. Applicants not receiving notification of selection are encouraged to submit an application for consideration the following year.

If schedules permit, the scholarship recipient and one parent will be hosted to participate in the 2007 D.A.R.E. International Training Conference for announcement and presentation of the scholarship.

AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

Upon verification of full-time enrollment, scholarship funds will be dispersed directly to the scholarship recipient. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books and other academically related expenses. An outline of how funds are to be spent must be submitted with enrollment verification.
